Her programme focuses not only on academic learning but also on developing the practical skills she needs in everyday life. Through regular practice, encouragement and support from the Paces team, Ramiyah continues to build her strength, coordination and confidence in her own abilities.

One of the most important parts of Ramiyah's journey at Paces has been the relationships she has built. She is a much-loved member of her class and enjoys spending time with her friends and the staff who support her each day. Ramiyah loves coming to school, and her enthusiasm and smile are a regular highlight of the school day.
